Chamberlin Files as Candidate for South Bend School Board

South Bend resident Kyle Chamberlin declared his intention to pursue an at-large seat on the South Bend Community School Corporation Board of School Trustees on Wednesday. Chamberlin marked the commencement of his campaign by filing a petition of nomination with the St. Joseph County Election Board to place his name on the ballot this November.

Recognizing the need for capable and honest leaders on the School Corporation's managing body, Chamberlin intends to restore his community's trust in public schools. "Residents of this area, both children and adults alike, deserve schools that are led by competent professionals," he said. "More than 3,500 teachers, administrators and staff in the South Bend Community Schools are doing everything they can to help our students succeed. Now they need a board that supports their hard work with vision and oversight instead of hampering their efforts with micromanagement. It is time to turn the page and write a new chapter for the South Bend Community School Corporation."

"Public education opens doors for children while simultaneously strengthening entire communities," said Chamberlin, 24, on why he is seeking the position. "The thirteen years I attended public schools, combined with my upbringing as the son of two public school teachers, provided me with many incredible opportunities. Now as I start to think about raising a family here in South Bend, I want to ensure that my children, and all their peers, will have access to those same opportunities."

A life-long resident of St. Joseph County, Chamberlin currently resides just north of downtown South Bend. A graduate of Mishawaka High School, he holds a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the University of Notre Dame and is presently enrolled at Notre Dame Law School. While pursuing his undergraduate degree, he worked as a substitute teacher for School City of Mishawaka and served as an adjunct instructor for multiple area high school music departments.
